The Atlantic Club of Bulgaria and the National Space & STEAM Cluster, staying true to our motto “*Ahead of the Future*”, have launched the annual Youth Science Festival **HELLO SPACE | Bulgaria Calling** for the sixth consecutive year. The upcoming edition will take place in **June 2026, at Sofia Tech Park**, under the patronage of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Bulgaria.

Earlier this year, ahead of the fifth edition of the festival in June 2025, we began conversations with your esteemed Embassy about **Türkiye’s potential participation**. Now, as we prepare for the sixth edition, we would like to continue these discussions well in advance in order to secure **Türkiye’s involvement** and ensure a stronger presence.

We are reaching out to inquire about the possibility of your support in two key areas:

1. Securing the participation of a distinguished astronaut and space expert—most notably, **Alper Gezeravcı**, as our main star guest speaker.
2. Identifying companies, educational organizations, and exhibitors from **Türkiye** to be featured in a dedicated “**Türkiye Corner**”, showcasing the country’s cutting-edge advancements in space technology, education, and research.

At the same time, we remain open and enthusiastic about exploring any additional ideas for partnership that the Embassy of the Republic of Türkiye may wish to propose, so that **Türkiye’s contribution** to the festival reflects its growing leadership in innovation and space exploration.

The main goal of the festival is to spark the imagination of children and youth, inspiring them to set their sights on Space, the Moon, Mars, and beyond, and to pursue the path to the Nobel Prize and other top achievements in STEAM fields.

- Hosted **dozens of astronauts, scientists, and innovators** from across the globe

Given **Türkiye's remarkable advancements in space exploration and innovation**, we would be honored to feature **Alper Gezeravcı, Türkiye's first astronaut**, as a keynote speaker. His presence would serve as a powerful source of inspiration for thousands of young minds and highlight **Türkiye's growing contributions** to space exploration and STEAM education. Beyond his participation, such an appearance would also showcase **Türkiye's leadership** in the region's scientific and technological future, reinforcing its role as a pioneer in space exploration and strengthening Bulgarian–Turkish cooperation in innovation and education.
