CALL FOR ENTRIES

Does the ebb and flow only occur in the sea? Time also recedes and returns. Memories approach and fade. Images disappear and reappear. Reality shifts, multiplies, and fragments. Today, we no longer live exclusively in a physical world. We constantly navigate between the digital and the real; reconstructing what we see, what we remember, and ourselves.

PIXELS OF TIME invites students to design time not merely as a measured concept, but as a produced, recorded, transformed, forgotten, and reconstructed visual experience. As an extension of the Biennial's Ebb and Flow theme, this call explores the digital tides of contemporary visual culture.

Because every pixel is a trace.

Every image is a memory.

Every moment is reproducible.

And every reproduction alters time.

EXHIBITION

The exhibition will be held in the ÇOMU Faculty of Fine Arts Exhibition Hall.

The exhibition will open on November 20, 2026

PARTICIPANT PROFILE

The competition is open to national and international associate, undergraduate, master's, PhD, and proficiency in art students from design and art related departments.

PRODUCTION PRACTICES

We encourage experimental and innovative approaches in this competition. Submissions may include kinetic typography, graphic imagery, animation, experimental moving image, digital collage, 2D/3D, generative design, and AI-assisted productions.



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THEMATIC FRAMEWORK

"EBB AND FLOW"

The submitted motion-based visual works can be associated with one or more of the following themes:

- Time and the Moment / Now
- Memory, Remembering and Digital Memory
- Reality, Simulation and Virtuality
- Screen, Pixel and Digital Image
- Archiving and Forgetting
- Loss and Reconstruction
- Repetition and Transformation
- Human-Technology Relations

CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- Each participant may submit only one artwork.
Duration: Artworks must be minimum 30 and maximum 60 seconds (00:30 - 01:00) long
Resolution: 1920x1080px (horizontal) (Full HD)
Format: MP4 or MOV
- The file name must be formatted as follows:
Name_Surname_Work Title_Technique_Size_Year.mp4
- ÇOMÜ Faculty of Fine Arts and 10th Çanakkale Biennale has the right to use the artwork images, along with the artist's name and artwork details, without paying royalties for promotion on social media, printed publications, and other promotional platforms.

Manifesto Text: A text of no more than 300 words explaining the conceptual framework, narrative, purpose, and creative approach of the work.

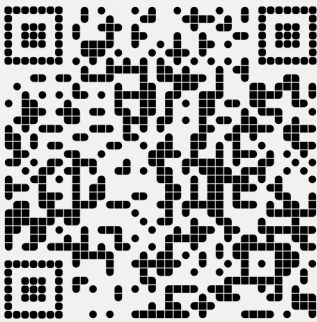
